



Dear Commander in Chief,

The commitment of our soldiers to keeping our country safe is unwavering. They deserve the same commitment from our country when it comes to their health and safety.

Mr. President, knowing of your concern for the safety of the men and women in America's Armed Services, we respectfully ask you to **halt White House efforts to give drug companies sweeping immunity** for deaths and injuries caused by dangerous or deadly vaccines and drugs.

Proposals to protect **negligent drug companies** are especially troubling for our soldiers given your administration's push to reinstate mandatory anthrax vaccinations. Recent news stories have reported that the Pentagon concealed from Congress multiple deaths and more than **20,700 hospitalizations related to anthrax vaccinations**. Yet service members too often must fight for years to receive medical benefits – if they receive them at all. No one is held accountable.

Subjecting service members to dangerous vaccines while giving protection to big drug companies is a threat to the health of all soldiers. They deserve better.
